Perception VS Reality



The Jews expected power, authority and splendor as a king which Jesus did not match



The disciples saw His lowly state but were redirected by the Spirit of God – No sign needed



This redirection came from THE Father!



...how that by revelation He made known to me the mystery (as I have briefly written already, by which, when you read, you may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ), which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets: Ephesians 3:3-5



At that time Jesus answered and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and have revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him. Matthew 11:25-27



But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him." But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. I Corinthians 2:9-11

Knowledge is helpful, but the Spirit puts it together



We may struggle with who Jesus is because:

- we try to fit Him into our bubble.
- the expectations we have don't match.
- He is simply not what we are looking for.



Accepting Jesus as He is will require us to: • see things differently. • decrease so He can increase.
